

Short Story Elements

1 PLOT This term refers to the **events** that take place in a story. It answers the questions "what happened?"

Typically the plot has:

2 FORESHADOWING Part of plot, this term gives a preview of **what will happen later** in the story.

3 FLASHBACK

Part of plot, this term gives a back story of events that took place earlier and that give an idea of the significance of what's happening now.

4 CONFLICT The issue to be resolved in the story.

There are different types of conflict that occur, including:

person vs. person struggle with someone else

person vs. self struggle in the character's own mind person vs. society struggle with school, the law, etc.

person vs. nature struggle with environment, weather, etc.

person vs. supernatural struggle with the supernatural like god, fate, etc.

person vs. technology struggle with a man-made object

5 CHARACTER Protagonist: The main character in a story.

Antagonist: The character who acts in opposition to the main character.

Not necessarily "the bad guy," but sometimes is.

6 SETTING The **TIME** a story takes place. Time includes **year**, **time period**, **time of day**, **season**...

The **PLACE** of the story's action. Place is the **room**, **building**, **city**, **country**...

The **ATMOSPHERE** of the place. Atmosphere includes **lighting**, **sounds**, **colours**...

7 TOPIC A general **idea** or **subject** dealt with in a story.

8 THEME Refers to the author's **main message** about the topic. Example: **Love hurts**

Example: All's fair in love and war

Example: **LOVE**
